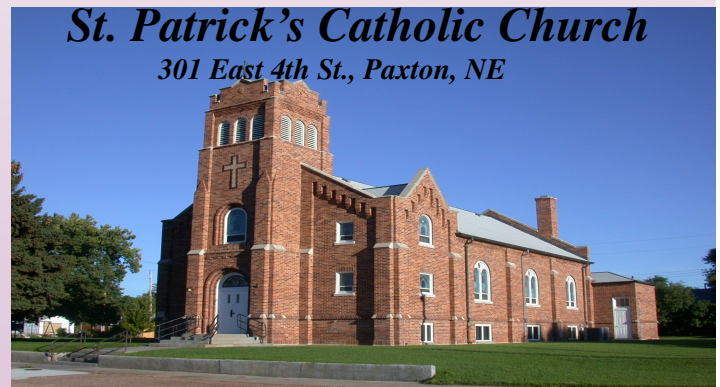

St. Luke's—Friday evenings at 6:00 p.m. during Lent.



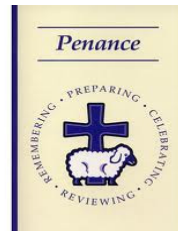
Fish Fry *Fish Fry on Friday evenings, following the Stations of the Cross at 6:00 p.m.*
