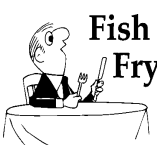
WEDNESDAY LENTEN SERVICE

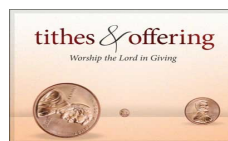
