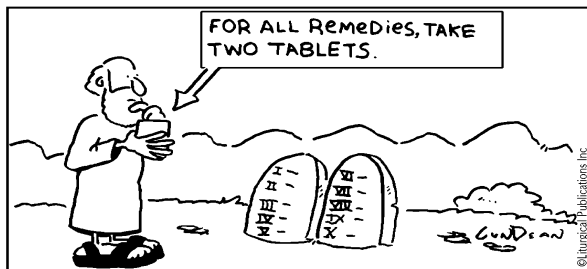


St. Luke's has an opening for Director of Religious Education and Secretary for St. Patrick's of Paxton.
